Install TS-DOS in your laptop computer, and you can list files both on disk and in RAM; then save to disk, load into RAM, kill, and rename files simply by selecting a file with the bar cursor and pressing a function key. A small portion of TS-DOS can be made RAM-resident, allowing you to save and load TEXT files to and from disk directly from TEXT (from the main menu of the NEC) and write BASIC programs that directly access disk files.
